In this case, UFO stands for UnFinished (quilting) Object not that funny thing you saw that night after you had a few glasses of wine.

If you have been quilting for more than a month or so, you probably have a UFO or two or three or four or.... maybe even 12 or more! If you have at least 12 – well this program is for you. For those who may not have 12 projects started but not finished, we can also define it as projects you would like to do "someday".

Here is how it's going to work. Before our meeting in January, you will need to make a list of 12 UFO projects you would like to work on in 2017. You do not need to decide when you will work on them or what order to them in. Just list them and give each a number 1-12.

Each month we will draw a number and it is the project with that number you should work on that month. Did you notice, we said "work on" not finish. Perhaps you will finish it and that is the best possible outcome, but progress is good too. We will draw the numbers at the meetings in the months that we meet and in the months that we don't meet the numbers will be drawn and communicated via the Guild's Facebook page and email. Since we meet the 4th Tuesday of each month that is when we will do the monthly drawing.

Also the guild's Facebook page will be a great way to share what we are working on each month and the progress we make. Of course we will always share at our Guild meetings.

Prizes? You want prizes? Ok, Just Threads will donate a small prize each month with a random drawing to someone who has participated that month. Show and Tell your project at the meeting or via Facebook and you can qualify. If you do not do Facebook you can contact someone who does and they can post for you.

Perhaps if there is enough interest we can have some UFO project days to get together and work on our projects.

This is meant to encourage and motivate us to finish some of our projects but most importantly to have fun and get to know some of our guild members better.
