### **Caring and Sharing**

### A message from Jane Miller and Linda Rohde

Since the September meeting, 39 quilts have been turned in. We will be doing something for the Caring & Sharing night in January. An e-mail will be sent to members letting everyone know what we will be working on. We still have some quilts from last year that need to be completed and turned in. Don't forget we have a fun incentive (see below) for all quilts made and handed in.

Personal Care & Toiletry Bags; As part of its community service projects, our Guild also makes toiletry bags for the Victim's Assistance shelter. The directions for the bag follows. If you wish to fill them, please include the following items: washcloth, shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste and lotion.

#### **Directions:**

- Cut a 26" x 11' rectangle
- Fold in half, right sides together to make a 13" x 11" rectangle
- Sew a 1/2" seam up one side. On the opposite side, sew a 1/2" seam from the bottom fold, stopping 1 1/2" from the top.
- Fold the top edge over 1", wrong sides together, then zigzag 1/4" from the raw edge all the way around.
- Create a flat bottom by sewing the two bottom corners diagonally.
- Thread a drawstring through the top of the pocket

Turn in a completed quilt and be entered in a drawing for quilting related prizes at the May meeting.


You can use your own supplies or fabric donated to the Caring and Sharing program. The outside dimension of the quilt will be measured to determine the number of tickets.

### Here are the Details!


1 Ticket small quilts: 200 inches

or less

2 Tickets large quilts: 201 in.+



Quilters will receive 1 or 2 tickets for each finished quilt they donate. If a group of people complete a quilt, only one will get a ticket.

**RULES** 

- 1. All entry forms for entries to be judged must be in by April 30, 2016. One form per entry. All entries must be in by May 13, 2016.
- 2. Items can be entered either as display only or to be judged. Quilts can only be entered in a show once. Judging will be done by the point system developed by NCQG.
- 3. There is no entry fee for members for the first three entries to be judged. Any items over three will have a judging fee of \$6 per item. Make checks payable to "North Country Quilting Guild". Donations will be gladly accepted. A judging fee of \$6 per item for non-members must be sent with entry form.
- 4. A detailed description of size, color, pattern and designer is requested to help in planning the setup of the show. Fabric swatches, a sketch or picture should be attached on the back.
- 5. Please indicate what is on the back of the quilt. There may be some entries that will need to have both sides shown providing space is available.
- 6. Any entry that includes work by more than one individual must have all parties listed on the entry form. Each individual should give permission to have quilt entered.
- 7. Tied quilts will not be judge.
- 8. A fabric Identification Tag with name of entrant should be sewn on the lower right back of the quilt. Do not use straight pins for safety reasons.
- 9. Each entry must be enclosed in a fabric bag/pillowcase with the entrant's name on the bag. No plastic or paper bags for the benefit of the quilt should be used. One entry per bag. This speeds up distribution of quilts at the end of the show. An "acknowledgment of entry" and entry tags will be sent to the entrant. The tags must be sewn or safety pinned to the bag and to the lower back of the quilt. Remove tags from previous shows because they are numbered and it causes **confusion.**
- 10. Entries are to be received at the arena at Gordon Cerow Recreation Park in Clayton, N.Y., between 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Wednesday, June I, 2016.
- 11. ENTRANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN INSURANCE ON ITEMS ENTERED. There will be twenty-four hour security provided.
- 12. All quilts should have at least a fmished 5" sleeve for hanging. The sleeve should go from edge to edge and sewn evenly to make the quilt well. If the quilt is wider than 96", please leave a gap of about three inches in the center of the quilt. We do not have poles wider than 96" or taller than 96".
- 13. All entries will remain on display throughout the show. No exceptions.
- 14. Entries must be picked up between 4:45 and 5:15 p.m. on Sunday, June 5, 2016. No entry will be released prior to that time. All quilts have to be accounted for before any are distributed. Ifyou are designating another individual to pick up your quilt, send a note authorizing such.
